

Many of you have met our new Attendance Officer Lisa Johnson, who comes to school every Wednesday to check registers. At Whale Hill School we have an attendance target of 96% as we don't want any of the children to miss out on learning and special events. However we appreciate that children are poorly occasionally especially as the cold weather approaches but don't forget school staff are happy to administer medicine to help them to keep going. Please check that prescribed inhalers kept in school are full and in date. Lisa has asked you to help us to improve school attendance by:

- Trying to make medical appointments outside of the school day.
- If daytime appointments are unavoidable- bring children straight back to school after their appointment.
- Bring children to school if they are slightly under the weather often seeing friends in school is remedy enough for the winter blues.
- Do not ask for a holiday in term time as we cannot authorise this and it will result in a fine.

Please arrive on time.

We have noticed that since installing the new registration system a large amount of children are arriving late. Please make sure the children are on the school yard in plenty of time each morning; we ask that children are brought onto the yard at:

Lower school 8:50

• Middle/Upper school 8:35

This way they are all ready to start lessons on time each day.

Online Safety

The children enjoyed a drama production by an online safety group last week and we hope they shared the safety messages with you at home. In school we have filters and systems in place to make sure the children are safe online, however the children tell us, that some of them access unsuitable material when at home or visiting friends. Unfortunately there are social network APPS that are easily available to people who aren't who they say they are. <u>Please visit the NSPCC site for online safety advice.</u>

If your child becomes ill or is involved in an accident we need to be able to contact you or another family member. Children can become very upset if they are taken ill in school and no one comes to take them home. Don't forget to let us know if you have changed your telephone number.

<u>Safe Arrival</u>

Please make sure that your child arrives safely in school each day. Children in lower school need to be accompanied by an adult who must supervise them on the yard until they are brought into school at 8:50. If you bring your child to school in a car always consider others and park legally and please resist from performing what parents have described as 'the American drop off'!

School Dinners

We have noticed that more children are choosing to bring packed lunches rather than have a school dinner. Please make sure that healthy food is included and limit high fat or high sugar items to a minimum. School dinners are very good value priced at £2 a day and many parents prefer the option of a hot meal for their children in the winter. Please contact the school office if you would like to change to school dinners but remember to give us 2 weeks' notice as all ingredients are fresh and need to be ordered.

Dinner money needs to be paid **in advance** at the start of each week and not the end. Please ask Mrs Lee for dinner money envelopes.
