During our recent safeguarding audit concerns were raised about children being dropped off and coming into school by themselves. Please make sure that if you bring your child to school by car that you:

- Park safely and legally.
- Accompany your child to the school entrance.
- If your child attends breakfast club we ask that you personally hand over your child to a member of staff at the door.
- Children in lower school need to be accompanied by an adult who must supervise them on the yard until they are brought into school by staff at 8:40 am.

PE Uniform

We have recently sent information out on Parent mail reminding families about our PE uniform with a special notice about shoes. Our policy states that all children need plimsolls or trainers; in some cases we have loaned PE shoes to children who have forgotten to bring them so that they do not miss PE, which is a favourite lesson for many children. However this is something that we have been advised not to do any longer due to:

- Risk of slipping and falling when wearing ill- fitting shoes
- Risk of spreading foot infections

After the Christmas holiday children who do not have the correct PE footwear will not take part in the lessons as we must at all costs ensure that children are safe in school. School plimsolls are relatively inexpensive and we understand may be free at Grangetown library. As with all school clothing please make sure you have written your child's name inside; we always encourage children to be responsible for their possessions in school but inevitably some of the younger children loose things and this helps us to reunite children with their clothing.

The sports partnerships advises that in some aspects of PE such as gymnastics and apparatus work, shoes are not to be worn due to safety. Parents and carers who have concerns about children picking up infections such as verrucae during barefoot lessons, may like to include a verruca sock or sticky tab sports socks with PE kit to protect against this.

Please help your child to have the correct **PE kit ready for the start of term on Monday January 6th.** For children in upper school we consider this to be good preparation for secondary where penalties for not bringing PE uniform are much harsher.
