- 1. Pupils to arrive at 8.00am and line up socially distancing and enter at Stay and Play door. Parents should not enter the building.
- 2. Rec Y3 pupils to hang bags on pegs in Stay and Play. Y4 Y6 pupils to hang their bags on their peg in their cloakroom.
- 3. Children to be kept in their year group bubbles; one table per year group.
- 4. Tables to be spaced throughout the hall.
- 5. A gap of one seat should be left between pupils and they should not face others across the table.
- 6. Pupils' breakfast will be brought to them to eliminate the risk of queueing.
- 7. Parent Mail booking system to continue. No cash transactions and no late bookings allowed.
- 8. Departure will be staggered: pupils will depart for class when it is their class's turn to arrive at school.
- 9. Parents will be told to only book pupils in if the use of the provision is reasonably necessary to support them to work, seek work, undertake education or training, attend a medical appointment or address a medical need or attend a support group. This does not include apply to vulnerable pupils.
