I	How was your experience of home learning? Could we have improved anything? What will you need most help with now that we are back?	'Home learning was good but not as easy to understand the work and was hard to control it on a screen.' 'It was hard because my Mam couldn't even explain it to me because she didn't know the answers.' 'I think I need help with telling the time.' 'I need help with English work.'
2	Did you prefer live lessons or doing the work in your own time?	Most children preferred the zoom lessons.
3	Is work in class interesting and challenging? Is it ever too easy?	'Good challenge.' 'Sometimes the maths is easy.'
4	How do your teaching assistants help you?	'She helps me to find the answers when I'm stuck.' 'Mrs Cowap helps me if I get confused and shows me how to do the work.' 'They read things out to you if you are stuck.'
5	Is your work marked regularly? How does it help?	Whole class said yes definitely. 'It tells us what is wrong so we can do it again.'
6	What makes you happy in school?	'My friends.' 'Seeing everyone.' 'Maths!' 'Playing outside with my friends.' 'Clubs after school.' 'Special afternoons like Halloween.' 'Science.'

7	Is behaviour good at Whale Hill?	Whole class said yes.
8	What would you do if you had any worries? How could we improve our wellbeing provision?	'Tell a friend or tell a teacher.' 'Tell your parents or Grandparents.' 'Tell a teaching assistant.' 'Tell Miss Offiler.' 'Tell Mrs Butterfield.' Lots of children in the class would like an opportunity to attend wellbeing club. Kitten/puppy room.
9	Do you attend any lunchtime/after school clubs?	Most children in the class put their hands up for after school clubs.
10	Are there any lunchtime/after-school clubs you would like to suggest?	'Rugby club.' 'Maths club.' 'Skateboarding club.' 'Girl's Football club.' 'Science club or football or basketball club.' 'English, history or spelling club.' Geography club.' 'Puppy training club.'
11	Does Whale Hill promote British Values?	Children were unsure but mentioned democracy, kindness, respecting people, friendship. They said we might learn about them in PSHE.
12	Is there a friendly atmosphere in school?	All class agreed yes. 'No bullying.' 'Teachers talk with you and make sure you are okay.' 'No fighting.'

13	What do you think makes a lesson good?	'Learning about new stuff.' 'Having a good teacher.' 'Listening to each other.' 'Teachers will help you.'
14	What can make it hard for you to learn?	'Sometimes I read something and can't understand it.' 'Sometimes questions can be confusing the way they are set out.' 'Too noisy in small classroom when we try and do partner and groupwork.'
15	How could school improve?	'Early finish on a Friday.' 'Oil painting. Full day of art.' Full subject days. 'Craft days.' 'Drama club or drama lessons.' 'Longer playtimes and lunchtimes- especially lunchtime as we sometimes only get five minutes outside.'
