Phonics and Reading

In Reception, the children have begun their phonics journey, learning to recognise sounds and blend them to make words. Alongside daily phonics sessions, we are sharing a wide range of stories to build vocabulary and foster a love of reading. You can support your child at home by enjoying books together, talking about stories, and practising the sounds we send home each week.



Maths

In Reception, the children are exploring maths through play and practical activities—counting, sorting, building, and spotting patterns in the world around them. We focus on developing early number skills and a strong sense of curiosity and problem-solving. You can support at home by counting everyday objects together, noticing shapes, and talking about numbers in daily life.
