Reading

Reading is one of the most important skills your child will learn. Please listen to them read their school reading book at least three times a week -daily if possible - to help build confidence and fluency. Your child will also bring home a 'reading for pleasure' book to enjoy as a bedtime story. Sharing stories together helps grow their imagination, build language skills, and develop a lifelong love of reading.

Maths

In Maths, we follow the National Curriculum with support from White Rose Maths. This term, children will focus on counting, number and place value, addition and subtraction, and simple shapes. You can help at home by practising counting, spotting numbers and shapes in everyday life(like on doors or shopping), and playing simple number games.
