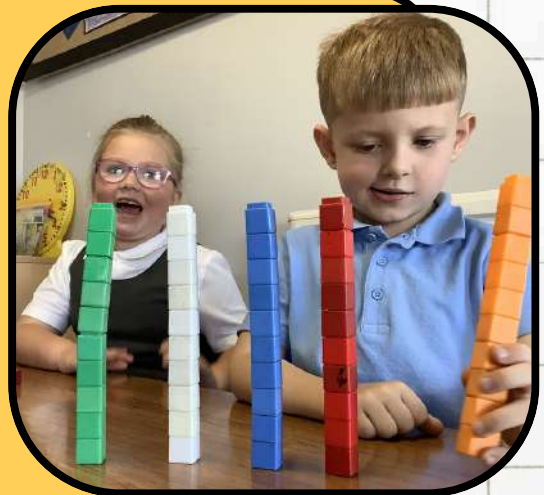
Reading



In Year 2, we will continue to follow the Read Write Inc. phonics programme to support children's reading development. For those who complete the programme and move beyond the Grey group, they will transition to using Oxford Reading Buddy, which helps further develop their reading comprehension and fluency. It remains really important that you read with your child at least three times a week-ideally every day-to help build confidence, vocabulary, and a lifelong love of reading.

Maths

In Maths, we will continue to follow the National Curriculum with support from White Rose Maths. This term, Year 2 children will focus on number and place value within 100, addition and subtraction using two-digit numbers, and identifying the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. You can help at home by practising counting forwards and backwards in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s, spotting numbers and shapes in everyday life (such as on doors or when shopping), and playing simple number games to build confidence and fluency.
