## Reading

Reading is one of the most important skills your child will learn and will make sure that they are well prepared for the future. Sharing stories together helps grow their imagination, build language skills, and develop a lifelong love of reading.



## Maths

In Maths, we follow the National Curriculum with support from White Rose Maths. This term, children will focus on, number, place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. It is important that your children practise their times tables in year 3 they should know their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10s. They can practise at home by logging onto TTRS.
