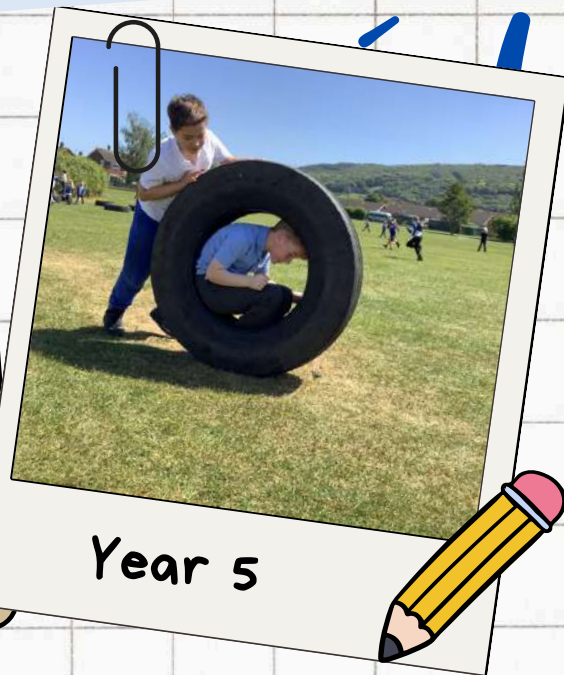

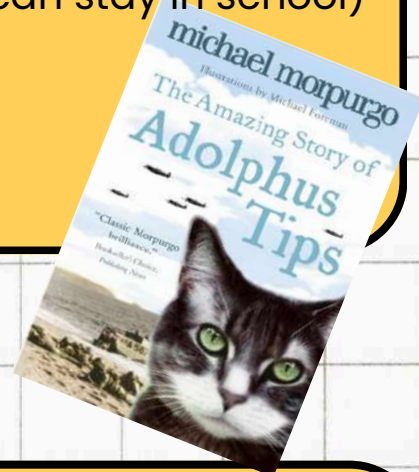
Welcome to Year 5!

Daily checklist

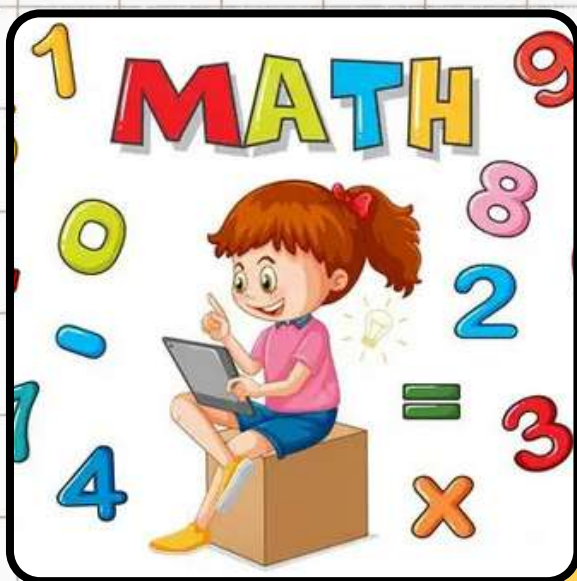
- ✓ PE - Friday

Reading

Reading is one of the most important skills your child will learn, therefore we would like them to have regular practice. Please listen to your child read their school reading book at least four times a week - daily if possible - to help build confidence, fluency and understanding. Sharing stories together helps grow their imagination, build language skills, and develop a lifelong love of reading as well as helps to improve their writing too.





Maths

In Maths, we follow the National Curriculum with support from White Rose Maths. This term, children will focus on number, place value and calculation. We will be focusing on fine tuning skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and will look at equivalent fractions and how to order them. At home, you can help your child in Maths by teaching and encouraging them to tell the time.
